FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

(1) What does Neo Networks provide?

Jason: Neo Networks is a 501 (C) 3 nonprofit organization that provides services to students of all demographic categories that gives them the opportunity to improve their knowledge in several subjects

(2) When was Neo Network established and who has the company worked with?

Jason: Neo Networks was established in January 2006. In the last fifteen years, we have worked with several after school programs in the metropolitan area (Future Foundation, Job Corps, DeKalb Workforce, Senior Centers, and etc.) which included a multicultural group of diverse students from the inner city and refugees from African Countries. We also created mentoring groups, provided homework help, taught computer literacy, and provided food and nutrition classes. We provided scholarships to several students to go to Georgia Tech, Clayton State University and University of Georgia.

(3) What type of classes does Neo Networks offer?

Jason: We will continue to revisit and evaluate

(4) When are the classes held?

Jason: We continue to focus mostly on online classes because this is easier on the students and their parents

(5) Which schools are Neo Networks currently focusing on?

Jason: We are currently focusing on high schools and colleges in DeKalb area. We are open to other students who are interested in being tutored within the metro area.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Continue to support/sponsor after school events, example: October fest, end of year celebrations, sponsor students for summer school programs, field trips, provide back to school supplies. This year we have donated 4 more AMAZON Tablets to the after-school program. We were informed by the Program Director that the students are using them to complete their homework projects.
